



What is a SAM Registration?

A System for Award Management (SAM) Registration is the first step in securing government contracts. To do business with the federal government, SAM registration and a CAGE code are required. It's necessary to get paid for selling to the government, and must be completed before applying for any certifications. The registration is valid for one year and should be renewed 60 days before expiration.
